

4. Science-oriented education (postgraduate studies)

The purpose of postgraduate studies - educational programme of science-oriented education - is to train specialists who have the skills to plan and independently conduct scientific research, deep theoretical knowledge, allowing them to prepare a qualifying scientific work (dissertation) for the degree of Candidate of Sciences. Upon completion of postgraduate studies, provided that the graduates successfully pass the final certification, they are awarded a diploma of researcher of the established sample and are assigned the scientific qualification 'Researcher'.

Postgraduate studies are carried out in full-time, part-time and co-research forms of education. Term of study: full-time - up to 3 years, part-time - up to 4 years, coresearch - up to 5 years.
